STUDENT & GUARDIAN FEEDBACK REPORT 2022-2023 MANOHARI DEVI KANOI GIRLS' COLLEGE


INTRIDUCTION

Manohari Devi Kanoi Girls' College is a reputed Girls' institution in Dibrugarh, Assam. It is affiliated under Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh. The college offers B.A., B.Sc. at Under Graduate level. Presently more than 1500 students are studying in this college. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College has been working continuously on quality improvement and the betterment of student learning experiences. In order to analyze the lag areas of the college and scope for further improvement, feedback from various stakeholders have been received. This report focuses overall feedback of students on infrastructure, curriculum and institution. On the other hand the guardians also gave their views on 10 parameters.


DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

As a part of Best practice adopted by the college, feedback regarding various aspects of the college was collected from outgoing students of 6th semester, parents/guardians. The process involved distribution of predesigned forms (a Google form) sent to students for responses regarding their curriculums and institution. On the other hand another form given to parents asking for responses regarding the institution, curriculum, governance and infrastructure and also inviting suggestions for further improvement. In order to achieve a comprehensive result, useful statistical tools like percentage and pie diagram have been used.


STUDENTS FEEDBACK (WITH 17 PARAMETERS) PART-I (COURSE CONTENT)




In so far depth of the course content is concerned, 97% of the student respondents opined that the course is adequate and only 3% found it to be inadequate.




Out of 389 student 88% of the students responded that their course was relevant to real life situations. Only 12% of them did not agree to its relevance.




Adhering to the curriculum of Dibrugarh University, internal assessment in the form of Sessional examinations, seminar/group discussions, attendance etc. are conducted by all departments of the college. About 95% of the respondents said that the internal assessment system helped them to improve their qualitative standard, while only 5% of them did not agree with that.




The college has certain welfare schemes for students such as scholarships, free studentships for meritorious and financially weak students, insurance facilities etc. In inviting feedback in this regard, it is found that 94% of the respondents are aware of them, while 6% are not aware.



It is found that about 90% of students expressed satisfactions about the allocation of hours and credits to the courses, while 10% of students put their views against it in this regard.




In response against the question, maximum number of students (291) responded in favour of using of audio-visual aids in the class by the faculty member while a minor section (98) were responded against it.




PART-II (Infrastructure, Extra Curricular activities etc.)

In accordance with the facilities, a large section of students (121) rated their classroom with very good option. 203 students expressed it as good and 58 expressed as average while only 7 no of student rated their classes poor respectively.



Library is an integral part of an educational institution. It should be well equipped with books, journals, periodicals, newspapers as well as internet and reprography facilities. It should provide a good environment for reading. In so far as the library facility of the college is concerned, it is found that 74 numbers of respondents viewed the library as very good, 182 numbers viewed good, 74 numbers found as average and 16 respondents found the facilities poor.




Computers are nowadays an integral part of education. It gives students access to collect suitable information in various fields, which help them to build up their career. The college authority is trying to improve and upgrade computer facilities for the students. In response to the above, 140 of the respondents opined that computer facility provided to them was good, 47 no. found it to be very good, 138


no. found average, while a smaller number of students (48) said it poor while 16 no. students left the response without any comments.



In response, out of 389 students , it was found that 82 no. of the respondents thought that cooperation from the office staffs was very good, 171 no. responds good and 107 nos. said that it was average, while 26 no of student felt that their relation with the supporting staffs was poor and 3 no. of students not answered.




So far as washroom facilities are concerned, it was found that 156 of them thought it to be good, 53 put their views as very good, while 132 of them opined the




facilities to be average and altogether 46 of them expressed it poor while 2 students do not have any comment.


NCC and NSS activities are necessary to instill among the students with a sense of accountability towards community, institution and Country. Participation in such activities makes them responsible citizens of the nation.101 numbers of the students opined that the NCC/NSS activities in the college was very good,175 numbers said good, 81 rated these as average and 25 gave their opinion as poor. Above all only 2% of student not put any interest in this field.




Extra-curricular activities are essential part to express the inherent talents of the students. Out of 389 respondents 81 rated the extracurricular activities organized by the college were very good, 149 as good while 119 as average.32 rated them as poor and 8 have no any answered.



Almost 41%(160 students) of the respondents felt that the recreational facilities available in the college were good, 57 respondents rated as very good. Beside that 128 and 34 nos of students rated the facilities as average, and poor respectively. On the other hand 3% students not answered in that respect.



The college tries to provide all possible facilities for sports within its limited space. The facilities provided by the college found to be very good only by 15% respondents, while 38% respondents considered as good and 34% rated those facilities as average. Only 11% students rated the facilities to be poor.2% no comment.



As a Girls' college, we try to dispense all possible facilities for Health Care within its limited source. The facilities provided by the college found to be very good by 46 respondents, while 151 respondents considered good and 130 rated these facilities as average. Only 50 and 12 students rated the facilities to be poor and without comments.



Hostel is the second home for each and every border, so it should have a healthy environment for better education. Facilities Provides by the Authorities respondent with a positive rate. Besides this, a few numbers of students expressed their views as poor where 69 no of students do not have any comments.

Suggestions Given:

- **1.** Common room for girls should be provided at science block
- 2. Make enough provisions for smart Classes.
- **3**. Improve sanitation facilities in the washroom (Science Block).


4. Improve library facilities with more books and references related with current syllabus.

- 6. Provide Generator for Hostel.


GAURDIANS FEEDBACK REPORT




Most of the Guardians fill pride for admission in this Institution. Almost 92% express their satisfaction in this matter.




Around 90% of the parents admit that the procedure of admission was absolutely fine. Beside this 6% opined disagree in that process.




Most of the Guardians express that their children's knowledge improved through regular interaction with their faculties.




Out of 159 responses, 142 Guardian agree that the Discipline of the College was good.




Most of the parents thought positive and agree with the Healthy learning atmosphere of the Institution. Only 3% disagree with the view where 6% are stay away from their answer.




In This regard, out of 159 responses, 136 parents look positive change in their wards behavior. On the other hand 6 no of respond and not agree with this question.




It seems that almost all respond express their high regard for the College.

ANALYSIS THE REPORT

The analysis of the results indicate that students have rated their course is adequate and relevant to their real-life situation. Provision of internal assessment is really helpful. A large number of respondents express that online classes may not be substitute for physical classes. Beside these library facilities, washroom facilities, activities of NCC & NSS for developing a healthy education environment were quite satisfactory. On the other hand, some facilities which are concerned with computer, sport, health care, hostel and canteen were mostly good but in these sectors, it is needed to be more qualitative improvement. Parallely, the responses from the guardian is satisfactory regarding admission process, discipline, quite learning atmosphere of the College, website etc. On the other hand, Parents were expressing their most positive view about course curriculum and behavior or cooperation from administrative staff.
